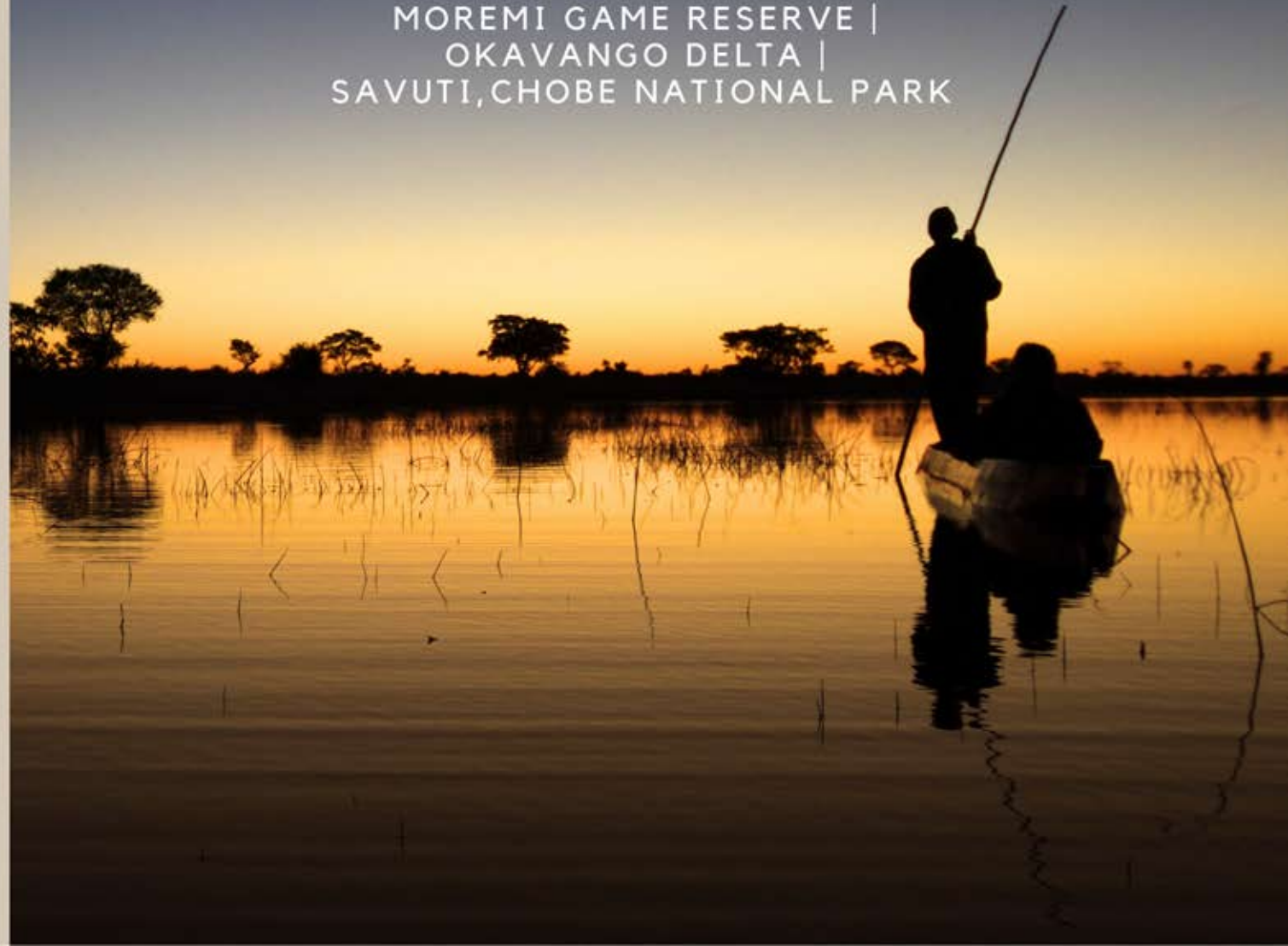

## DAY 1 TO DAY 4: CAMP MOREMI

*Highlights - Camp Moremi  
motorised boating trips | Camp  
Moremi game drives*

On arrival at Maun airport, you will be met by a representative who will assist you with boarding your light aircraft transfer to Camp Moremi. Landing at the Moremi airstrip, your guide will meet you and transfer you by road to Camp Moremi where you can settle into your luxurious room. You will spend the next three nights at Camp Moremi enjoying game drives and boating excursions as you search for the prolific wildlife that inhabits the Moremi Game Reserve.

## DAY 4 TO DAY 6: XUGANA ISLAND LODGE

*Highlights - Mokoro Safaris | Bird  
watching safaris*

Enjoy a final morning game drive and transfer to the airstrip for your flight to Xugana Island. Situated in the north-western corner of Botswana, the Okavango Delta is a World Heritage Site as it is the largest inland delta in the world. The magnificent Okavango River sprawls out over the dry sands of the Kalahari Desert forming this flourishing waterlogged oasis featuring countless meandering waterways and crystal-clear lagoons studded with water lilies, as well as fertile floodplains and reeded islands inhabited with abundant wildlife.

## DAY 6 TO DAY 8: SAVUTE SAFARI LODGE

*Highlights - Savute Game drives to  
the Savute Marsh*

After a last morning activity in the delta, depart for your air hop to Savute where activities are centred around game drives throughout the Savute area in open 4x4 safari vehicles. Many trips will incorporate a visit to the famous Savute Marsh for your chance to see the historic presence of the Savute Channel against a teeming backdrop of wildlife. Visit to the ancient San rock paintings at Gubatsa Hills, a small hilly outcrop which forms a remarkable landmark in the otherwise flat landscape.



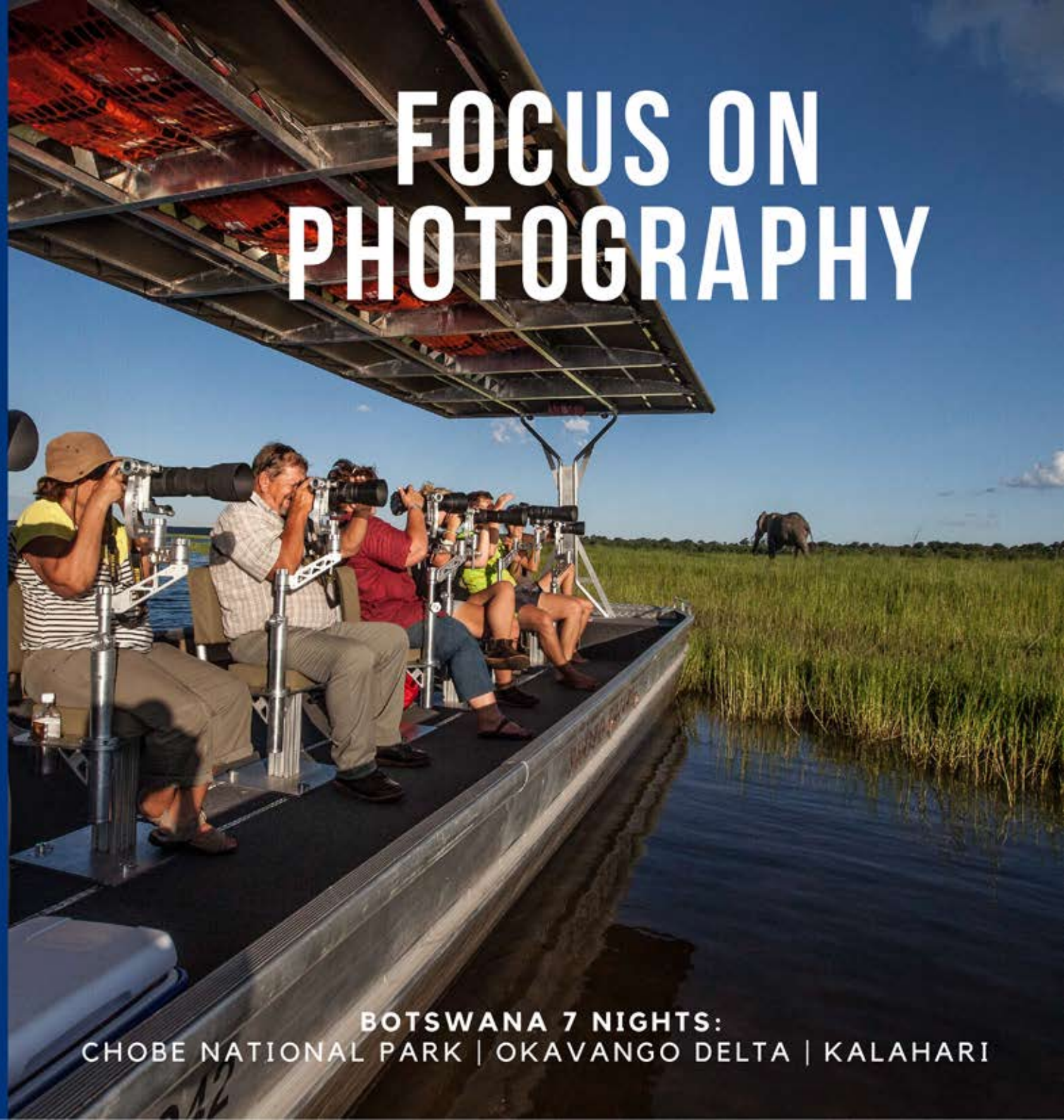
## DAY 8: END OF JOURNEY

## DAY 1 TO DAY 3: PANGOLIN HOTEL

*Highlights – River-and land-based safaris in specially kitted-out vehicles ideal for photography.*

On arrival at Kasane Airport transfer to the hotel. Built around a wildlife photography gallery once you have checked in and settled in your room you will meet the Pangolin photo host who will be taking care of you on your land and water-based activities while in the Chobe.



## DAY 3 TO DAY 6: LITTLE VUMBURA CAMP

*Highlights – Mokoro Safaris | Bird watching safaris*

Transfer to Kasane Airport for the short hop to Vumbura Airstrip. The Okavango Delta is the largest inland delta in the world. The magnificent Okavango River sprawls out over the dry sands of the Kalahari Desert forming this flourishing waterlogged oasis featuring countless meandering waterways and crystal-clear lagoons studded with water lilies, as well as fertile floodplains and reeded islands inhabited with abundant wildlife.



## DAY 6 TO DAY 8: DINAKA CAMP

*Highlights – Desert-based photo safaris*

Transfer to Vumbura airstrip for the short air hop to Dinaka. An exclusive private conservancy hugging the northern edge of the Central Kalahari Game Reserve, Dinaka is host to one of the most unique bio-diversities in Southern Africa.

## DAY 8: END OF JOURNEY

After a last morning activity, transfer to Dinaka Airstrip for the return flight to Maun.
